- ▶ Application deadline for students: May 31st

Summer semester

- ▶ Nomination deadline for partners: October 15th
- ▶ Application deadline for students: October 31st

Nomination and Application Process

Students have to be nominated through the coordinator of their home university. Please send the **student's name, date of birth, e-mail address, field of study as well as study level (BA/MA) by e-mail to ciem@fh-wien.ac.at**. We will then send a link to our online application form directly to the student's e-mail address. Students have to fill in the online application form; no further documents need to be sent in hardcopy.
