<p>APPLICATION PROCEDURE</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - CIEM receives official student nomination from partner university - CIEM contacts nominated student by sending her/him an e-mail with a link to an online application form and our application guide. - Incoming student completes application by the above mentioned deadline - Student needs to upload a proof of identification (valid ID card or passport) and a passport photo. No further documents are needed for the application. - Student will be informed about further steps (course selection, acceptance letter, etc.) after the above mentioned application deadlines.

<p>MANDATORY RESIDENCE REGISTRATION WITH MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENT 62 (MA62)</p>	<p>According to Austrian law you have to register with the authorities. <p>RESIDENCE REGISTRATION WITH MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENT 35 (MA35)</p>	<p>Students with EU/EEA or Swiss nationality who are staying in Austria for more than 3 months have to apply for a confirmation of registration (<i>Anmeldebescheinigung</i>) within four months of arrival.
