Narrowing down your topic and research question specifies the scope and focus of your BA/MA thesis. This depends on existing research in the field and your own data/material. The aim of this workshop is to use your own topics and discuss how to develop and phrase your research question, objectives, and aim of your thesis. You will also get some general tips for next steps to outline your thesis. Get the most out of this workshop by preparing in advance: get an overview of the literature in the field of research, think about your research interest and your access to data or material.

How to (re-)write a paragraph

An effective paragraph has to be convincing and it has to "flow". The structure and flow of your main argument plays a key role in achieving this, which will be a common theme in this workshop. By looking at sample texts, we will gather key points that make up an effective paragraph, noting principal patterns to build an argument. Learn about (multilingual) drafting strategies and how to use revision strategies for your paragraphs on all three levels (content, structure, language), including formal style and register of Academic English.

Writing Consultations



A writing consultation is a confidential conversation that focuses on your own work and any questions or challenges around it.

Possible topics of writing consultations include:

- Writing difficulties and writer's block
- Finding, narrowing down, and researching topics
- Structure, outline and argumentation
- Excerpting and paraphrasing scientific sources
- Scientific/academic language
- Text revision
- Citation
- Grammar and spelling
