Summarising and paraphrasing techniques

Writing any academic text entails interacting closely and critically with the existing secondary literature in the field. In order to import this into our own texts we can either quote, summarise or paraphrase. While quotations should be kept to a minimum, the key academic skills of summarising and paraphrasing are used extensively. Through worked examples and practical exercises, this workshop will look at when and how we go about doing these, including the use of note making, the Cornell summarising method and the linguistic techniques used to change the language sufficiently to avoid plagiarism.

How to develop a research question

Narrowing down your topic and research question specifies the scope and focus of your BA/MA thesis. This depends on existing research in the field and your own data/material. The aim of this workshop is to use your own current or past topics and discuss how to develop and phrase your research question, objectives, and aim of your thesis. You will also get some general advice for next steps and outlining your thesis. Get the most out of this workshop by preparing in advance: get an overview of the literature in the field of research, think about your research interest and your access to data or material.
